

The Pine Bluff/Jefferson County Library System is undergoing major renovations. We understand this is an inconvenience and do apologize. The renovations are needed to update the libraries.

Please note that the Main Library will remain open and there are e-books and movies available through the electronic resources. The Arkansas State Library recently purchased 50 online magazines which are now available for check out.

The Altheimer Library is schedule to reopen at the end of September if the shelving is delivered. The library is looking very nice, with new blinds, paint and floors. The circulation desk has been expanded and bright new lights have been installed. The meeting room has a new look for its kitchen area with new drawers, new tile counter, a new microwave and a larger refrigerator.

The Watson Chapel and Redfield libraries have started construction. Each of these branches is having square footage added. Redfield's meeting room will be expanded while Watson Chapel will get a new meeting room for the community. Each will have new lights, flooring, paint and a rearrangement of the interior. Staff is busy selecting new books to add to the libraries when they open. Both will open in March 2020 depending on weather.

The White Hall Library will close on September 30 with packing of materials to begin on October 1. Holds may be placed and picked up on Wednesdays at the White Hall Museum between 9:30 and Noon beginning October 9. Books may be returned on Wednesdays or at the Main Library. The expected time to reopen is the beginning of 2020, just after the holidays. Keep up to date on the renovation on our Facebook page "White Hall Library".

While the libraries are closed, download eBooks using the LIBBY app or visit the Main Library at 200 East 8th Avenue in Pine Bluff. Check out Hoopla for downloadable movies, audiobooks, music and more. Books and DVDs are available at the Main Library and Altheimer until the renovation projects are complete.
